In each episode the pair demonstrate tying 3 to 4 fly patterns, including a variety of types; dry and wet flies, droppers, and steelhead. Ever fished a Maggot? How about a Papa Smurf? Carolyn and LeRoy are always keeping an eye out for new patterns, and new materials to add to old stand-bys. Both fish all across the country, reeling in "killer" fly patterns along the way.
